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BUYER'S AGENT OF THE YEAR Cate Bakos Empower Wealth



What is your buyer's agent experience?

My career history is unique, to say the least. I graduated as an industrial chemist. I found my skills in sales and marketing at Dulux. I cut my teeth in property 10 years ago (and upset my parents quite a bit to leave corporate for real estate), and time as a mortgage broker gave me enough cash flow expertise to realise my dream and launch a buyer's advocacy business. I have been working as an advocate, property investment advisor and director here at Empower Wealth for almost three years. The most vital experience I have had, though, has been as an investor. I embarked on my own property journey when I was 21 and haven't looked back.

How does it feel to win this award?

I'm really humbled. A client of mine nominated me without any warning or hint, and it's been particularly thrilling knowing that I sourced and purchased their property for them before I met them in person. The mere fact that they trusted me to do so, flew here and saw the property and then felt compelled to nominate me means more than any other style of nomination. This award is particularly special – I'm a regular contributor to



YIP, and I remember immersing myself in the publication when I was a younger investor, and I gleaned so much.

What's the best purchasing advice to follow?

Don't listen to your heart or go with your gut feel if it's an investment. There should be way more science to any significant purchasing decision. Be methodical, considered, commercial and unemotional. I've seen buyers convince themselves that holiday houses are great investment choices, or worse, high-rise apartments in oversupplied areas for their son/daughter to reside in. If you are taking advice from an 'expert', make sure they are independent to the transaction and not taking commission as a representative of the seller.

How do you achieve your best results for clients?

I think that the best results I've achieved for clients have been through working my good agent relationships, introducing clients to off-market properties and staying close to the action so that I can get all of the good background information in preparation for a property showdown. Obviously I work out who I like to work with and who I choose to avoid, but I make sure that I have a great relationship within each office at every opportunity.
